Brazil plans US\$285 billion infrastructure push

Brazil's president is prepared to spend US\$285 billion for infrastructure improvements in the South American nation.

Brazilian President Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva has pledged massive spending to build highways, railways, ports and housing projects to help ensure the country's economy maintains its brisk expansion.

Millions of jobs will be created as Brazil becomes an "immense construction site", said the country's president.
